They've got \$5,000. Next stop: \$1,000,000 Lottery players win their way into special million-dollar drawing

(Madison)— Three very lucky Wisconsinites have qualified for a special \$1,000,000 multi-state drawing associated with the Wisconsin Lottery's "Deal or No Deal" instant scratch game. Their names were drawn today from 121,450 mail-in entries.

Each of these players wins \$5,000 and one chance to win \$1,000,000 in a "Deal or No Deal" multi-state drawing in September.

In January three other Wisconsin Lottery players won trips to Hollywood where they vied for special cash prizes PLUS a chance to take part in a special lottery winner's episode of "Deal or No Deal." Jeanine Waraska of West Bend won \$5,000 and made it to the special show, where she won an additional \$146,000.

The \$1,000,000 drawing and the Hollywood trip drawing were part of the Lottery's \$5 "Deal or No Deal" instant ticket, which went on sale in September, 2007. Developed in concert with the popular NBC game show the scratch game featured the program's well-known logo, 18 briefcases and a Prize Board with 19 slots.
