4 “Million Dollar Draw” \$100,000 prizes claimed Lottery validates tickets sold in Appleton, Janesville, Luxemburg & Racine

(Madison) — Four of the ten players who won \$100,000 in the Wisconsin Lottery’s Million Dollar Draw game have claimed their prizes:

Mary Vanden Elsen of Kimberly

won with ticket #344426 that she bought at American Petroleum in Appleton.

Sharon Costeran of Janesville

won with ticket #277743 that she bought at Rollette Oil in Janesville.

Kandis Zeinert of Neenah

won with ticket #051608 that she bought at Simonar Shell in Luxemburg.

James Hilgenberg of Racine

won with ticket #101113 that he bought from 4 Mile Food & Liquor in Racine.

Each of these \$100,000 winners receives \$68,250 after taxes.

\$100,000 winning Million Dollar Draw tickets sold in Fredonia, Hustisford, Mauston, Reedsburg, Rice Lake, and Weston have not yet been claimed.

Million Dollar Draw was a limited-time on-line game offered by the Wisconsin Lottery in which 500,000 \$10 tickets were available from March 4th through April 28th. On May 1st the Lottery drew 511 ticket numbers from the 345,625 tickets that were actually sold. The first ticket number drawn became the game’s one \$1,000,000 top prize winner. The next ten were each worth \$100,000. Five hundred other ticket numbers won \$1,000 each.
