Two more “Million Dollar Draw” \$100,000 prizes claimed Reedsburg & Weston tickets validated

(Madison) — Two more players who won \$100,000 in the Wisconsin Lottery’s Million Dollar Draw game have claimed their prizes:

Mary Henke of Reedsburg

won with ticket #005256 that she bought at Viking Express Mart in Reedsburg.

Jacqueline Saukup of Weston

won with ticket #339588 that she bought at Callon Quik Mart in Weston.

Each of these \$100,000 winners receives \$68,250 after taxes.

Six of the ten \$100,000 winning Million Dollar Draw tickets have now been validated. Tickets sold in Fredonia, Hustisford, Mauston, and Rice Lake have not yet been claimed.

The Million Dollar Draw’s lone \$1,000,000 prize was won by Shawn Eddy of Rhinelander. Of the game’s 500 \$1,000 prizes, 230 have been claimed so far.

Million Dollar Draw was a limited-time on-line game offered by the Wisconsin Lottery in which 500,000 \$10 tickets were available from March 4th through April 28th. On May 1st the Lottery drew 511 ticket numbers from the 345,625 tickets that were ultimately sold. The first ticket number drawn became the game’s \$1,000,000 top prize winner. The next ten were each worth \$100,000. Five hundred additional ticket numbers won \$1,000 each.
