Rhineland man claims \$1,000,000 prize from Lottery's "Million Dollar Draw"

(Madison) — Over the last couple of days the million dollar question has been: Who has ticket 165681, the ticket drawn Tuesday as the \$1 million winner in the Wisconsin Lottery's Million Dollar Draw game?

The answer: Shawn Eddy of Rhineland.

Eddy made the long drive from "Hodag Country" to the Lottery's headquarters in Madison where the Million Dollar Draw ticket he purchased at his local Citgo Quik Food Mart was validated as the game's top prize winner.

Eddy receives \$682,500 after taxes.

Eddy will take part in a news conference at 10:30am, Monday, May 7 at the Rhineland store. Please note: This will be the only time Eddy intends on making himself available to the press. He will not answer questions before or after Monday's news conference.

Million Dollar Draw was a limited-time on-line game offered by the Wisconsin Lottery in which 500,000 \$10 tickets were available from March 4th through April 28th. On May 1st the Lottery drew 511 ticket numbers from the 345,625 tickets that were actually sold. The first ticket number drawn became the game's one \$1,000,000 top prize winner. The next ten were each worth \$100,000. Five hundred other ticket numbers won \$1,000 each.
