Lots of tickets, little time left for best chance ever at \$1 million!

(Madison) — If you're still hoping to cash in on the best odds ever of winning \$1 million you're running out of time. Sales for the Wisconsin Lottery's Million Dollar Draw game end this Saturday at 9pm.

The game began in March with 500,000 \$10 tickets available. On May 1st, the Lottery will draw one ticket from among the tickets sold and one lucky person will win \$1 million. In addition, ten other Million Dollar Draw players will each win \$100,000 and 500 players will win \$1,000.

That's 511 prizes in, at most, 500,000 chances. Those are great odds. If the Lottery sold all 500,000 tickets in the game, and you bought just one of them, your odds of becoming Wisconsin's newest millionaire would be a fantastic 1:500,000, while your odds of winning *at least* \$1,000 would be an astounding 1:978.

But as we near the end of the Million Dollar Draw sales period, the odds of winning a prize are now even greater than when the game started. As of this morning, just over 300,000 tickets have been sold. That means with just one \$10 ticket purchase your odds of winning are even better than before: 1:300,000 of winning \$1 million; 1:587 of winning at least \$1,000!

But the clock is ticking. Tickets are available at more than 3,500 retail locations around the state and must be purchased before 9pm, Saturday, April 28th to qualify for the Million Dollar Draw.
