Two winners claim their shares of a \$12,000 Badger 5 jackpot



(Madison) —Two tickets sold in Adams and Marinette County matched all five numbers in the Wisconsin Lottery's \$12,000 Badger 5 drawing Tuesday, March 25.

Both ticket holders have come forward to claim their half of that prize, \$6,000.

Dennis Lunquist of Arsdale won his \$6,000 share with a ticket he bought at Dave's Escape, 1203 State Rd. 13 in Friendship.

Judith Porfilio of Pound won her half of the \$12,000 jackpot with a ticket she bought at Northland Mini Mart, Rt. 1, 216 Henerietta St. in Crivitz.

The winning Badger 5 numbers on March 25 were 03, 09, 13, 15 and 25.

For selling those winning tickets, each store earns a \$240 commission from the Lottery. Lottery retailers who sell winning tickets with prizes of \$600 or more earn the equivalent of 2% of the prize, up to a maximum commission of \$100,000 per ticket. The winning ticket commission is based on the original value of the prize, regardless of the number of tickets that may claim a share of it.

Badger 5 is a \$1 daily terminal-generated game with jackpots that start at \$10,000 and grow a minimum of \$1,000 a day until they are won. Players win the rolling jackpot by matching their five numbers to the five winning numbers drawn each night.
