'Tosa man claims his half of \$215,000 Badger 5 jackpot



(Madison) —Curtis Volkman of Wauwatosa has claimed his share of a \$215,000 Badger 5 jackpot from Friday, April 11.

Volkman had one of two tickets that matched all five winning numbers in the April 11 drawing. Those tickets, which split the \$215,000 jackpot, are each worth \$107,500.

Volkman purchased his \$107,500 winner at Sendik's Market, 2315 N. 124th St. in Brookfield.

His ticket was a \$1 quick pick that matched the winning numbers of 04, 12, 15 24 and 27.

For selling Volkman's winning ticket, Sendik's earns a \$4,300 commission from the Lottery. Lottery retailers who sell winning tickets with prizes of \$600 or more earn the equivalent of 2% of the prize, up to a maximum commission of \$100,000 per ticket. The winning ticket commission is based on the original value of the prize, regardless of the number of tickets that may claim a share of it.

Badger 5 is a \$1 daily terminal-generated game with jackpots that start at \$10,000 and grow a minimum of \$1,000 a day until they are won. Players win the rolling jackpot by matching their five numbers to the five winning numbers drawn each night.
