## Minocqua woman claims half of \$12,000 Badger 5 jackpot



(Madison) —Joyce Ratzlaff of Minocqua has claimed her half of a \$12,000 Badger 5 jackpot from Thursday, April 3.

Ratzlaff had one of two tickets that matched all five winning numbers in the April 3 drawing. Those tickets, which split the \$12,000 jackpot, are each worth \$6,000.

Ratzlaff purchased her \$6,000 winner at Trig's Food & Drug, 70 W. Shopping Center in Minocqua. One set of numbers on her \$5 computer quick pick ticket matched the April 23 winning numbers of 09, 10, 16, 19 and 31.

For selling Ratzlaff's winning ticket Trig's earns a \$240 commission from the Lottery. Lottery retailers who sell winning tickets with prizes of \$600 or more earn the equivalent of 2% of the prize, up to a maximum commission of \$100,000 per ticket. The winning ticket commission is based on the original value of the prize, regardless of the number of tickets that may claim a share of it.

A second winning ticket sold in the April 3 drawing, also worth \$6,000, was purchased in Milwaukee.

Badger 5 is a \$1 daily terminal-generated game with jackpots that start at \$10,000 and grow a minimum of \$1,000 a day until they are won. Players win the rolling jackpot by matching their five numbers to the five winning numbers drawn each night.
