## **Cambridge woman claims remaining half of \$75,000 Badger 5 jackpot**



(Madison) — Julie Crawford of Cambridge has closed the books on the Wisconsin Lottery's May 4 Badger 5 lotto drawing, by claiming her half of that night's \$75,000 jackpot. A Pardeeville woman claimed the other half last week.

Crawford bought her winning ticket, worth \$37,500, at Cambridge Gas & Motel, 281 W. Main St., Cambridge. The middle set of the three quick pick number sets she purchased matched all five winning numbers in the May 4 drawing to claim a share of the \$75,000 jackpot.

May 4<sup>th</sup>'s winning Badger 5 numbers were 09, 16, 17, 22 and 31.

After taxes Crawford receives approximately \$25,000.

For selling Crawford's ticket, Cambridge Gas & Motel earns \$1,500 from the Lottery. Lottery retailers who sell winning tickets with prizes of \$600 or more earn the equivalent of 2% of the prize, up to a maximum commission of \$100,000. The commission is calculated on the full prize even if there are multiple winning tickets.

Winning ticket-holders have 180 days from the date of the drawing to claim their prizes by going to the Lottery's Madison or Milwaukee offices, or by mail.

Badger 5 is a \$1 daily lotto game with jackpots that start at \$10,000 and grow a minimum of \$1,000 a day until they are won. Players win the rolling jackpot by matching their five numbers to the five winning numbers drawn each night.
