Pardeeville woman claims her half of \$75,000 Badger 5 jackpot



(Madison) — Teresa Carpenter of Pardeeville has claimed her share of the Wisconsin Lottery's \$75,000 Badger 5 lotto jackpot from Monday, May 4. Carpenter had one of two winning tickets for that jackpot, earning her half the prize, or \$37,500.

Carpenter's \$1 computer quick pick ticket matched all five winning numbers in the Monday May 4th drawing. Those numbers were 09, 16, 17, 22 and 31.

After taxes, Carpenter receives just under \$26,000.

Carpenter bought her winning ticket at Portage Super Stop, W8425 Crawford Rd., Portage. For selling that ticket, Portage Super Stop earns \$1,500 from the Lottery. Lottery retailers who sell winning tickets with prizes of \$600 or more earn the equivalent of 2% of the prize, up to a maximum commission of \$100,000. The commission is calculated on the full prize, regardless if there are multiple winning tickets.

The second \$37,500 winning ticket from the May 4th drawing has yet to be claimed. That ticket was purchased at Cambridge Gas & Motel, 281 W. Main St., Cambridge.

Winning ticket-holders have 180 days from the date of the drawing to claim their prizes by going to the Lottery's Madison or Milwaukee offices, or by mail.

Badger 5 is a \$1 daily lotto game with jackpots that start at \$10,000 and grow a minimum of \$1,000 a day until they are won. Players win the rolling jackpot by matching their five numbers to the five winning numbers drawn each night.
