Five Badger 5 tickets split \$80,000 jackpot Two of the tickets sold at the same Racine County store!

(Madison)—Lightning struck five times Friday night in the Wisconsin Lottery's Badger 5 game. It struck twice, in fact, in the exact same spot.

Five tickets in four different counties matched all five winning numbers in the Friday Badger 5 drawing, with two of those tickets sold from the very same store. The tickets split the night's \$80,000 jackpot, meaning each one is worth \$16,000.

Grove Liquor, 1118 15th Ave. in Union Grove sold two of the five winning tickets. The others were sold by: **Casaloma Express, 4735 Converters Dr., Appleton; Falls Liquor, 1098 Fond du Lac Ave., Sheboygan Falls; Pick 'N Save, N78 W14501 Appleton in Menomonee Falls.**

Friday night's winning Badger 5 numbers were **01, 02, 03, 05, and 06.**

Ticket holder's have 180 days from Friday's drawing to claim their prizes.

Badger 5 is a \$1 daily terminal-generated game with jackpots that start at \$10,000 and grow a minimum of \$1,000 a day until they are won. Players win the rolling jackpot by matching their five numbers to the five winning numbers drawn each night.
