Two Badger 5 tickets split \$206,000 jackpot

(Madison)—Lightning struck twice Tuesday night in the Wisconsin Lottery's Badger 5 game.

Two tickets matched all five winning numbers in last night's Badger 5 drawing. The tickets split the \$206,000 jackpot, meaning each one is worth \$103,000.

The winning tickets were sold by **Triangle, 903 S. Adams in New Lisbon** and **Kwik Trip, 322 N. Division in Stevens Point**.

Last night's winning Badger 5 numbers were **03, 14, 18, 19 and 20**.

Ticket holder's have 180 days from Tuesday's drawing to claim their prizes.

Badger 5 is a \$1 daily terminal-generated game with jackpots that start at \$10,000 and grow a minimum of \$1,000 a day until they are won. Players win the rolling jackpot by matching their five numbers to the five winning numbers drawn each night.
