Beaver Dam man claims share of \$29,000 Badger 5 jackpot



(Madison) —Dennis Brooks of Beaver Dam has a little bit more money for the holidays now that he has turned in one of two winning tickets from the Wisconsin Lottery's Thursday, November 6 Badger 5 drawing. Brooks's ticket and one sold in Crivitz matched all five winning numbers in the November 6 drawing to claim equal shares of the night's \$29,000 jackpot.

Brooks bought his \$14,500 ticket at Kwik Trip, 1504 N. Center in Beaver Dam. After taxes he receives \$9,897.

For selling that winning ticket Kwik Trip earns \$580. Wisconsin Lottery retailers that sell winning tickets with prizes of \$600 or more earn the equivalent of 2% of the prize, up to a maximum commission of \$100,000. The commission is calculated on the amount of the original prize, regardless of the number of tickets that may claim a share of it.

The winning numbers Brooks matched on November 6th were 07, 10, 19, 22 and 29.

Badger 5 is a \$1 daily lotto game with jackpots that start at \$10,000 and grow a minimum of \$1,000 a day until they are won. Players win the rolling jackpot by matching their five numbers to the five winning numbers drawn each night.
