Back to back Badger 5 double winners *Iowa and Walworth County tickets are latest to split jackpot*



(Madison) —For the second straight drawing and the fourth time this month two tickets sold in the Wisconsin Lottery's Badger 5 lotto game matched all five winning numbers to claim equal shares of the latest jackpot.

Tuesday night, two tickets sold in Lake Geneva at Urma's Lakeside Deli and Convenience, 880 W. Main St., and in Ridgeway at Badger Mart, 408 Main St., split the \$11,000 jackpot.

Each ticket is worth \$5,500. The ticket-holders have 180 days to claim their prizes by going to the Lottery's Madison or Milwaukee offices, or by mail.

Tuesday night's winning Badger 5 numbers were 18, 21, 25, 29 and 31.

Monday night Badger 5 tickets sold in Markesan and Manitowoc split a \$67,000 jackpot. Badger 5 players have split jackpots four times in November so far.

Badger 5 is a \$1 daily lotto game with jackpots that start at \$10,000 and grow a minimum of \$1,000 a day until they are won. Players win the rolling jackpot by matching their five numbers to the five winning numbers drawn each night.
