Greenfield man has 17,000 reasons to give thanks this season

(Madison)—Thanksgiving comes with ALL the trimmings this year for David Carlson of Greenfield.

Carlson bought a \$4 quick pick ticket for the Wisconsin Lottery's \$17,000 Badger 5 drawing on Saturday, November 17 and turned that ticket into a \$17,000 winner. Carlson's second set of numbers matched Saturday night's five winning numbers—02, 09, 14, 18 and 22—to claim Saturday's jackpot.

Quick Pick Foods, 4306 W. Layton Ave. in Greenfield sold Carlson his \$17,000 winning ticket and earns a \$340 commission from the Lottery. Lottery retailers who sell winning tickets with prizes of \$600 or more earn the equivalent of 2% of the prize value, up to a maximum of \$100,000 per winning ticket.

Carlson's \$17,000 jackpot came one night after a \$197,000 Badger 5 jackpot was hit by three people in Green Bay, Greenville and Milwaukee.

Badger 5 is a \$1 daily terminal-generated game with jackpots that start at \$10,000 and grow a minimum of \$1,000 a day until they are won. Players win the rolling jackpot by matching their five numbers to the five winning numbers drawn each night.
