Back to back jackpot winners in Dane and Douglas counties Jackpots of \$61,000 and \$10,000

(Madison)—This week provided another “two-fer” in the Wisconsin Lottery’s Badger 5 jackpot game.

A ticket sold in Middleton matched all five winning numbers in the Wednesday, November 21 Badger 5 drawing. The jackpot was \$61,000. The winning ticket was sold at Copps Food Center, 6800 Century Ave.

Wednesday’s winning numbers were 05, 07, 08, 14 and 27.

The very next night, Thursday, November 22, a ticket sold in Superior hit all five winning numbers to claim a jackpot of \$10,000. The winning Superior ticket was sold at Holiday Stationstore, 4827 E. 2nd St.

Thursday night’s winning Badger 5 numbers were 01, 10, 16, 29 and 30.

Badger 5 is a \$1 daily terminal-generated game with jackpots that start at \$10,000 and grow a minimum of \$1,000 a day until they are won. Players win the rolling jackpot by matching their five numbers to the five winning numbers drawn each night.
