Fort Atkinson man claims share of \$119,000 Badger 5 jackpot

(Madison)— Robert Klotz of Fort Atkinson has validated one of two winning tickets in the Wisconsin Lottery's December 8th Badger 5 drawing. The Badger 5 jackpot on that night was \$119,000.

Klotz's share of the prize is \$59,500. He won it on a \$2 quick pick ticket he purchased at the Fort Quick Mart, 342 Whitewater Ave., Fort Atkinson. One of the two sets of numbers he bought matched the December 8th Badger 5 winning numbers (01, 08, 10, 28 and 30).

For selling Klotz's winning ticket the Fort Quick Mart earns a \$2,380 commission from the Wisconsin Lottery. Lottery retailers who sell winning tickets with prizes of \$600 or more earn the equivalent of 2% of the prize value, up to a maximum of \$100,000. The winning ticket commission is based on the original value of the prize, regardless of the number of tickets that may claim a share of it. In this instance the original prize was \$119,000. Both selling retailers thus earn a commission based on that figure.

The other winning ticket from the December 8th drawing was sold in Muskego. It has not yet been claimed.

Badger 5 is a \$1 daily terminal-generated game with jackpots that start at \$10,000 and grow a minimum of \$1,000 a day until they are won. Players win the rolling jackpot by matching their five numbers to the five winning numbers drawn each night.
