Badger 5 jackpot hit three days in a row Big winners in Waukesha, Germantown, Janesville, Milwaukee

On Friday, February 22 one ticket claimed the night’s \$243,000 Badger 5 jackpot. That ticket was sold at Sentry, 2308 W. St. Paul Ave. in Waukesha. Friday’s winning Badger 5 numbers were 05, 14, 16, 19 and 22.

Then on Saturday, February 23 two winning tickets claimed a share of the night’s \$18,000 jackpot. Those tickets, each worth \$9,000, were sold at Maple Road Mobil, W188 N10963 Maple Road in Germantown, and at Woodman’s Food Market, 2901 N. Lexington Drive in Janesville. Saturday’s winning numbers were 04, 09, 12, 17 and 19.

And to round out the weekend, Sunday night’s \$10,000 jackpot was won with a ticket purchased at El Rey Mexican Products, 1023 S. 16th St. in Milwaukee. Sunday night’s winning numbers were 06, 08, 09, 17 and 30.

Badger 5 is a \$1 daily terminal-generated game with jackpots that start at \$10,000 and grow a minimum of \$1,000 a day until they are won. Players win the rolling jackpot by matching their five numbers to the five winning numbers drawn each night.
