Uhm, make that four days in a row for Badger 5 Jackpot hit again, this time in Sauk County



(Madison) —The Wisconsin Lottery daily game with a rolling jackpot is on quite a roll of its own.

After back-to-back-to-back Badger 5 jackpots were won Friday through Sunday, the game began the new work week on Monday exactly where it left off—with yet another jackpot winner.

Monday's winning Badger 5 jackpot ticket, worth \$11,000, was sold at Kwik Trip, 101 S. Albert Avenue in Reedsburg. Monday night's winning numbers were 05, 14, 19, 21 and 29.

That's now four in a row for Badger 5.

The streak began on Friday, February 22 when one ticket sold in Waukesha claimed the night's \$243,000 jackpot.

On Saturday, February 23 two winning tickets sold in Germantown and Janesville claimed a share of the night's \$18,000 jackpot. Those tickets were each worth \$9,000.

And on Sunday, February 24 the night's \$10,000 jackpot was won with a ticket purchased in Milwaukee.

So far, none of those prizes have been claimed. Winners have 180 days from the date of the drawing.

Badger 5 is a \$1 daily terminal-generated game with jackpots that start at \$10,000 and grow a minimum of \$1,000 a day until they are won. Players win the rolling jackpot by matching their five numbers to the five winning numbers drawn each night.
