## Chippewa Valley residents claim Lottery prizes



(Madison) —Mark Mathews of Altoona and Norman Rufeldt of Sand Creek have claimed major prizes in two different Wisconsin Lottery games.

Mathews won \$114,000 in the Lottery's June 28 Badger 5 lotto drawing with a \$5 quick pick ticket he bought at Kwik Trip, 2327 N. Clairemont in Eau Claire. The winning Badger 5 numbers on June 28 were 11, 15, 26, 27 and 29.

Mathews received \$76,665 after taxes.

Rufeldt won \$10,000 in the June 15 Mega Millions jackpot game. The ticket he bought at Joe's Family Market in Bloomer matched four of the five regular winning numbers drawn on the 15<sup>th</sup> plus the Mega Ball, making it good for \$10,000.

Rufeldt took home \$6,725 after taxes.

The winning Mega Millions numbers on June 15 were 04, 12, 13, 21 and 27, with a Mega Ball of 46

For selling these winning tickets the retailers earned additional commissions from the Lottery. Lottery retailers who sell winning tickets with prizes of \$600 or more earn the equivalent of 2% of the prize, up to a maximum commission of \$100,000. Kwik trip earned \$2,280 for selling Mathews his Badger 5 winner, and Joe's Family Market earned \$200 for selling Rufeldt's Mega Millions ticket.
