Time running out on \$100,000 Neenah lottery ticket **Unclaimed "Holiday Millions Raffle" ticket expires June 27**



(Madison) — In ten days time a great opportunity might go unrealized.

More than six months ago someone purchased a Wisconsin Lottery "Holiday Millions Raffle" ticket in Neenah. That ticket turned out to be one of ten \$100,000 winners in a drawing that was held on New Year's Day.

It also turned out to be the only one of the ten that has not been claimed. And the 180-day claim period ends on Friday, June 27.

"We hope someone just forgot he had this ticket and can still collect his \$100,000 prize," said Andrew Bohage, Lottery spokesperson. "We really love to pay our winners and it would be a shame if someone were to miss out on a prize like this."

The outstanding \$100,000 "Holiday Millions Raffle" ticket was purchased at the Quik Food Mart on south Commercial in Neenah. The raffle number on the ticket is 157638.

If the ticket is not claimed by June 27 the \$100,000 prize would then be added to the benefit funds the Lottery provides to taxpayers. Lottery proceeds in Wisconsin help reduce property taxes.
