Eagle woman feathers nest with \$250,000 prize

(Madison)—Cheri Fadrow of Eagle recently won \$250,000 playing the Wisconsin Lottery's "\$250,000 Cash" instant scratch game.

Fadrow beat 1: 320,000 odds to win one of the game's three quarter-million dollar top prizes. She matched her numbers to the winning numbers for the big win.

After taxes Fadrow received \$170,625.

"\$250,000 Cash" first went on sale in January. The \$20 instant game offers more than 325,000 cash prizes, ranging from \$20 to the top prize of a quarter million. The game is especially heavy with \$50 and \$100 prizes.

Players can win as many as 25 times on one "\$250,000 Cash" scratch ticket.
