Chetek man knows when to hold ‘em

(Madison)— **Raymond Miller of Chetek** recently won \$5,000 playing the Wisconsin Lottery’s “Championship Hold ‘Em” instant scratch game.

The \$5 game features 16 chances to win on each ticket, with a Cash Bonus spot, an “All-In” Bonus Spot and a top prize of \$50,000.

There are two “tables” on each ticket, each is played separately.

The ticket is modeled after the popular “Texas Hold ‘Em brand of poker. The goal is to get a better hand than the dealer with your cards and the community cards.



Miller bought his \$5,000 winning ticket at Kum & Go, 1910 McCauley Ave. in Rice Lake.

For selling that ticket, Kum & Go earns a \$100 commission from the Lottery. Lottery retailers who sell winning tickets with prizes of \$600 or more earn the equivalent of 2% of the prize, up to a maximum commission of \$100,000 per ticket.
