\$50,000 for solving the “Daily Crossword”

(Madison)— **Deanne Liebherr of West Bend** got more than a feeling of accomplishment when she “solved” the Wisconsin Lottery’s “Daily Crossword” instant scratch game.

Deanne also got \$50,000.

She purchased her winning ticket at Main St. Mobil, 500 S. Main St. in West Bend. For selling that ticket Main St. Mobil earns a \$1,000 commission from the Lottery. Lottery retailers who sell winning tickets with prizes of \$600 or more earn the equivalent of 2% of the prize, up to a maximum commission of \$100,000 per ticket.

“Daily Crossword” is a \$5 instant game with two puzzles per ticket, plus a bonus spot.

Players reveal 18 letters in the “Your 18 Letters” box and then scratch only the corresponding letters on the Crossword puzzles. When they complete three to 10 words in a puzzle in the classic up or down style of a crossword they win prizes ranging from \$5 to \$50,000.
