Two Rivers man claims \$14.4 million Megabucks prize



(Madison) –Terry Peters of Two Rivers is Wisconsin's newest millionaire.

Peters validated the sole winning ticket from Saturday's \$14.4 million Megabucks drawing at the Wisconsin Lottery's headquarters in Madison early this afternoon. The jackpot was the fifth largest in Megabucks history. Saturday's winning numbers were 03, 07, 12, 21, 27 and 30.

Peters chose to take the jackpot's single lump sum cash payment of \$7.6 million. He will receive approximately \$5.4 million after taxes.

Peters has agreed to take part in a news conference at 10:30am, Thursday, July 19 at the G V Unimart, 111 Church Street in Mishicot, where he bought his winning ticket. He says he will not be available to the press before, or any time following, that news conference.

Wisconsin has now had 61 Megabucks jackpot winners since the game began in 1992. Those 61 winners have claimed jackpots worth more than \$320 million.
