\$2.9 million Megabucks jackpot ticket sold in Waukesha County Powerball climbs to \$46 million



(Madison) —A ticket sold in Waukesha County matched all six winning numbers in the Wisconsin Lottery's \$2.9 million Megabucks drawing Saturday night.

The Saturday, March 29 winning Megabucks numbers were **10, 12, 13, 29, 38 and 44.**

**The \$2.9 million winning ticket was purchased at PDQ Food Store, N67 W27666
Moraine Drive in Sussex.**

The ticket holder has 180 days from Saturday's drawing to claim the prize. All Lottery prizes over \$500,000 must be claimed at the Lottery's headquarters in Madison.



Waukesha County also sold one of two \$10,000 Powerball tickets in the Saturday, March 29 Powerball drawing. That was at Muskego Market Place Foods, W189 S7847 Racine Ave. in Muskego. The other \$10,000 winning ticket sold in Wisconsin for Saturday's Powerball drawing was purchased at Glendale Mobil, 7156 N. Green bay Rd. in Glendale.

No one in any state matched all five numbers plus the Powerball to win the \$36 million Powerball jackpot Saturday. The new Powerball jackpot for Wednesday, April 2 is \$46 million (estimated annuity).

Saturday night's winning Powerball numbers were **18, 20, 25, 31 and 36.** The Powerball was **07** and the Power Play prize multiplier number was **05.**
