Holmen man claims \$4.1 million Megabucks jackpot



(Madison) —Jerry Nelson of Holmen became the Wisconsin Lottery's 62nd Megabucks jackpot winner late this afternoon when he presented lottery officials with the sole winning ticket from the Saturday, October 27 \$4.1 million Megabucks drawing.

"This is crazy," he said. "I can't believe it."

Nelson bought his winning ticket at Kwik Trip, 1550 S. Holmen Dr. in Holmen. Saturday night's winning numbers were **02, 18, 27, 31, 34 and 36.**

Nelson has not yet decided whether to take the \$4.1 million jackpot paid out over 25 years, or the single lump sum cash payment of \$2.26 million. He has 60 days to make that choice.

Kwik Trip earns a commission of \$82,000 from the Lottery. Lottery retailers who sell winning tickets with prizes of \$600 or more earn the equivalent of 2% of the prize value, up to a maximum of \$100,000.

Nelson and his wife Kathy have agreed to take part in a news conference tomorrow at the store. The Nelsons say they will not answer any questions from the press before or after that event.
