## **Three Sheboygan residents claim \$9.1 million Megabucks jackpot**

*News Conference in Sheboygan Monday*



(Madison) — The Wisconsin Lottery's \$9.1 million Megabucks jackpot drawing Saturday, November 8 produced one winning jackpot ticket, but three jackpot winners.

Richard Duening, Barbara Knauf and Curtis Lienau, all of Sheboygan, have claimed the \$9.1 million prize together. They have filed the necessary papers in Dane County Circuit Court to have the prize split equally among them.

Once the Lottery receives the court's order to split the prize, three equal payments will be made to them. They have chosen the jackpot's \$5.1 million lump sum cash option and will receive just over \$3.5 million after taxes. Split three ways, they will each receive \$1,169,120.

They bought their winning Megabucks jackpot ticket for the November 8<sup>th</sup> drawing at Q Mart, 2420 Calumet Dr. in Sheboygan. The winning numbers were 02, 06, 16, 41, 44 and 48.

For selling the ticket, Q Mart earns \$100,000. Wisconsin Lottery retailers who sell winning tickets with prizes of \$600 or more earn the equivalent of 2% of the prize, up to a maximum commission of \$100,000.

Duening, Knauf and Lienau have agreed to take part in a news conference Monday morning at Duening's business to discuss their long-standing lottery partnership and their recent good luck. They say they will refuse all interview requests prior to the event.
