Powerball rolls to \$125 million **Two \$10,000 winners in Kenosha County**



(Madison) —The Powerball jackpot grows to \$125 million (est. annuity) for this Saturday, February 21 after no one in any state matched all six winning numbers in the Wednesday, February 18th drawing.

Wisconsin had two \$10,000 winners Wednesday night and both of those winning tickets were sold in Kenosha County. One \$10,000 winner was purchased at R & D IV, 10477 120th Ave. in Pleasant Prairie. The other was sold at Southport Mobil, 7318 75th St. in Kenosha.

Winners at all prize levels have 180 days from Wednesday's drawing to claim their prizes at the Lottery's Madison and Milwaukee offices, or by mail.

Wednesday's winning Powerball numbers were **02, 15, 39, 44 and 56, with a Powerball of 15**. The Power Play prize multiplier was 03.



No one matched all six winning numbers to claim the jackpot in the Wednesday, February 18 Megabucks drawing. Wednesday night's winning Megabucks numbers were **03, 07, 13, 24, 41 and 48**. The Megabucks jackpot for Saturday, February 21 is \$3.1 million (estimated annuity).
