Powerball now \$153 million \$50,000 Power Play winner in Blair



(Madison) —No one in any state matched all five numbers plus the Powerball to win the \$133 million Powerball jackpot in the Wednesday, February 27 drawing, pushing the new jackpot for Saturday, March 1 to **\$153 million** (estimated annuity).

Wisconsin had one \$10,000 winning ticket in Wednesday night's drawing that became a \$50,000 winner, because the ticket holder also chose the Power Play multiplier option.

For an additional \$1 Power Play with every set of Powerball numbers purchased, players can multiply the non-jackpot prizes they win by as much as five times. The Power Play prize multiplier was 05 Wednesday night.

So \$10,000 became \$50,000.

The \$50,000 winning ticket was sold at Express Mart, 126 Spring St., Blair.

The winning Powerball numbers Wednesday night were **20, 24, 37, 48 and 53**. The **Powerball was 11**.



No one matched all six winning numbers to claim the jackpot in the Wednesday, February 27 Megabucks drawing. Wednesday night's winning Megabucks numbers were **06, 20, 23, 28, 32 and 33**. The jackpot for Saturday, March 1 is \$1.9 million (estimated annuity).
