Oregon man claims \$10,000 Powerball prize



(Madison) —Lucas Boettcher of Oregon has claimed one of three \$10,000 prizes won by Wisconsin Lottery players in the Saturday, February 23 Powerball drawing.

Boettcher bought his winner, a \$5 quick pick ticket, at Kwik Trip, 135 N. Main St. in Oregon. He won \$10,000 by matching four of the five regular numbers but not the Powerball in the Saturday night drawing.

Saturday's winning numbers were 08, 13, 23, 29 and 47. The Powerball was 32 and the Power Play prize multiplier was 04.

For selling Boettcher's ticket, Kwik Trip earns a \$200 commission from the Lottery. Lottery retailers who sell winning tickets with prizes of \$600 or more earn the equivalent of 2% of the prize, up to a maximum commission of \$100,000.

Two other \$10,000 tickets in Saturday's drawing were sold at the same store in Milwaukee.
