Wisconsin hits the Powerball jackpot! \$40.7 million winning ticket in Dane County



(Madison)—Wisconsin has its 13th Powerball jackpot winner!

A ticket sold in Dane County matched all six winning numbers in the \$40.7 million Powerball drawing Saturday, March 31.

The \$40.7 million ticket was purchased at Food Pantry/Diamond Jubilee, 981 N. Page Street in Stoughton.

Saturday night's winning Powerball numbers were 02, 05, 16, 36 and 40. The Powerball was 36 and the Power Play multiplier was 02.

The lucky jackpot ticket-holder has 180 days to claim the \$40.7 million prize. Once the prize is claimed, the winner then has up to 60 days to decide whether to take the \$40.7 million annuity jackpot paid out in 30 installments, or the jackpot's lump-sum cash value of \$19.3 million in a single payment.

Wisconsin has now had 13 Powerball jackpot winning tickets since the multi-state game began in April of 1992. The last Powerball winners in Wisconsin were the "100 Miracles," a group of Sargento cheese company workers in Fond du Lac. They won a \$208.6 million jackpot in August of last year.
