## **Jackson woman claims \$200,000 Powerball prize**



(Madison) —Talk about springing into summer.

Kathleen Brady of Jackson must be rarin' to go, now that she's a \$200,000 Powerball winner.

Brady won \$200,000 in the Wisconsin Lottery's April 8<sup>th</sup> Powerball drawing. She matched the five regular numbers drawn that night, but missed the Powerball to claim the game's \$200,000 prize.

The April 8 winning Powerball numbers were 01, 06, 48, 52 and 56, with a Powerball of 09.

After taxes, Brady receives \$136,500.

Brady bought her \$200,000 winning computer quick pick ticket at Tri-Par, 506 Wauwatosa Rd. in Cedarburg. For selling that ticket, Tri-Par earns \$4,000 from the Lottery. Lottery retailers who sell winning tickets with prizes of \$600 or more earn the equivalent of 2% of the prize, up to a maximum commission of \$100,000.
