Beaver Dam man has 10,000 reasons to like Powerball in April



(Madison) —For Earl Peck of Beaver Dam April showers have already brought more than the promise of May flowers. Peck has claimed a \$10,000 prize in the Wisconsin Lottery's Saturday, April 21st Powerball drawing.

Peck matched four of the five regular winning numbers drawn on the 21st, plus the Powerball to win his \$10,000 prize. He purchased two sets of numbers on a \$2 computer quick pick ticket at PKB Enterprises, 1301 N. Center St. in Beaver Dam.

After taxes, Peck received a check for \$6,825.

For selling Peck's winning ticket, PKB Enterprises receives \$200. Lottery retailers who sell winning tickets with prizes of \$600 or more receive a commission equivalent to 2% of that prize, up to a maximum commission of \$100,000.

Saturday's winning Powerball numbers were 22, 26, 28, 33, and 45. The Powerball was 17. Peck's numbers were 22, 26, 28, 45 and 51 with the Powerball of 17.
