Janesville man claims \$200,000 Powerball prize



(Madison) —A \$200,000 Powerball ticket sold in Janesville for the Saturday, April 18th Powerball drawing has been claimed at the Wisconsin Lottery's main office in Madison.

Marco Valencia of Janesville is the lucky winner. He matched all five regular numbers drawn on the 18th, but not the Powerball, for his \$200,000 prize. After taxes, Valencia received a check for just under \$137,000.

The winning Powerball numbers on the 18th were 22, 26, 28, 33 and 45, with a Powerball of 17.

Valencia purchased his winning ticket at Woodman's Food Market in Janesville. For selling that winning ticket, Woodman's earns a commission of \$4,000. Lottery retailers who sell winning tickets with prizes of \$600 or more earn a commission equivalent to 2% of that prize, up to a maximum commission of \$100,000.
