Big winners in April 30 Powerball draw claim their prizes Eden, Cedarburg, Milwaukee residents cash in major tickets



(Madison) —Three big winning tickets were sold in Wisconsin in the April 30th Powerball drawing.

Three big winners are now confirmed.

A winning \$200,000 ticket in the April 30 drawing has been claimed by Paul Oldenburg of Eden. Oldenburg bought his \$5 quick pick ticket at BFG, 127 E. Church Street in Oakfield.

A \$10,000 winner sold at Richard McKee Enterprises, 112 N. Port Washington in Grafton has been redeemed by Annette Jilek of Cedarburg. Annette bought a \$1 quick pick ticket.

John Stevens of Milwaukee also won \$10,000 in the April 30 Powerball drawing. He bought his winning ticket at CVS Pharmacy, 5740 S. Packard Ave. in Cudahy.

For selling these winning tickets the retailers earn special commissions. Wisconsin Lottery retailers who sell winning tickets with prizes of \$600 or more earn the equivalent of 2% of the prize value, up to a maximum commission of \$100,000.

BFG in Oakfield earns \$4,000 for selling the \$200,000 ticket; Richard McKee Enterprises and CVS earn \$200 each.

The winning Powerball numbers on April 30 were 01, 17, 25, 43 and 51, with a Powerball of 38.
