## **Green Bay woman wastes no time claiming \$10,000 Powerball prize**



(Madison) —Saturday night, a Powerball ticket bought by Eleanor Jacobs of Green Bay was just a piece of paper.

Now, less than 48 hours later, it's a nice chunk of change.

Jacobs wasted no time today, coming forward to claim her \$10,000 prize from Saturday night's Powerball drawing. She purchased her \$5 quick pick ticket at the I-43 Shell, 3285 Cedar Hedge Lane in Green bay. One set of numbers on that ticket matched four of the five regular winning numbers PLUS the Powerball in Saturday night's drawing to win Jacobs her \$10,000.

The winning Powerball numbers Saturday night were 02, 28, 36, 42 and 46, with a Powerball of 40.

For selling Jacobs her ticket, Shell earns a commission of \$200 from the Lottery. Lottery retailers who sell winning tickets with prizes of \$600 or more earn the equivalent of 2% of the prize value, up to a maximum commission of \$100,000.

Three other \$10,000 winning tickets were sold for Saturday's drawing in Fond du Lac, Pewaukee and West Allis.

A ticket sold in Minnesota claimed the drawing's \$180.1 million jackpot prize.

The Powerball jackpot for Wednesday, May 7 is \$15 million (est. annuity).
