\$200,000 Powerball prize from Superior claimed



(Madison) —Michael Kohn of Superior had 200,000 really good reasons to make the long drive south to Madison.

Kohn had a winning \$200,000 Powerball ticket from the Wisconsin Lottery's Wednesday, May 6th drawing. He validated that ticket at Lottery headquarters today.

Kohn's ticket matched all five winning numbers, missing only the Powerball number, to win the \$200,000 prize. The winning numbers that night were 07, 08, 12, 22 and 31, with a Powerball of 18.

After taxes, Kohn receives approximately \$136,500.

Kohn bought his ticket at The Shack, 3301-33 Belknap St. in Superior. For selling the ticket, The Shack earns \$4,000 from the Lottery. Lottery retailers who sell winning tickets with prizes of \$600 or more earn the equivalent of 2% of the prize, up to a maximum commission of \$100,000.
