## **Baldwin man claims \$10,000 Powerball prize**



(Madison) —A \$5 Powerball quick pick ticket turned out to be worth \$10,000 to Kenneth Nygaard of Baldwin.

With the fifth and final set of numbers on that \$5 ticket, Baldwin matched four of the five regular winning numbers and the Powerball in Saturday night's drawing to win his \$10,000 prize.

Nygaard validated his ticket today at the Lottery's redemption center in Eau Claire. He received a check for \$6,825 after taxes.

He purchased his winning ticket in New Richmond at Jor-Gas, Inc., 1893 Hwy. 63. For selling Nygaard's ticket, Jor-Gas earns \$200. Lottery retailers who sell winning tickets with prizes of \$600 or more earn the equivalent of 2% of the prize, up to a maximum of \$100,000.

Nygaard's winning ticket was one of three big winners in Wisconsin for Saturday night's Powerball drawing. A \$200,000 Powerball ticket was sold in Fennimore and another \$10,000 ticket was sold in Genoa City.
