South Dakota ticket claims \$232 million Powerball jackpot

Wisconsin has 8 big winners Wednesday



(Madison) —One ticket sold in South Dakota matched all six winning numbers in the Wednesday, May 27th Powerball drawing to win the night's \$232.1 million jackpot. The jackpot, originally estimated at \$222 million, came in higher due to heavier than expected sales around the country.

Wisconsin had eight major winners Wednesday night: One \$200,000 winner; six \$10,000 winners; and one \$10,000 winning ticket that becomes a \$30,000 winner with the Power Play prize multiplier feature. *

The \$200,000 winning ticket was sold in Waterford in Racine County at Waterford Self Serve, 200 N. Milwaukee Street.

Wednesday's winning Powerball numbers **05, 06, 12, 16 and 21, with a Powerball of 07.** The Power Play prize multiplier was 03.
