Big winners cash in on big Powerball jackpot draw

Five of Wisconsin's 8 big winners Wednesday have claimed prizes



(Madison) —More than half of Wisconsin's eight major winners in Wednesday's \$232 million Powerball drawing have claimed their prizes.

Dean Donaghy of Waterford claimed his **\$200,000** prize with a ticket he bought at Waterford Self Serve, 200 N. Milwaukee Street.

Alvena Foss of Baraboo claimed her **\$30,000** prize. Foss won \$10,000 on a ticket she bought at M & R Travelmart, 617 Pine St. in Baraboo, but because she also purchased the Power Play prize multiplier feature, her winning ticket was multiplied by Wednesday's Power Play number, which was 3.

Robert Siolka of Holmen validated his **\$10,000** winning ticket that he picked up at Federation Co-op, N5885 Hwy. 54 in Black River Falls.

Jacques Besaw of Larsen claimed a **\$10,000** prize with the ticket he bought at Woodman's Food Mkt., 595 N. West Hill Blvd. in Appleton.

Stefan Makowski of Chicago claimed a **\$10,000** prize with the ticket he purchased in Kenosha at Anjum Enterprises, 8211 Sheridan Rd.

Three other \$10,000 winning tickets sold in Appleton, Jefferson and Neenah have not yet been turned in. Ticket holders have 180 days from the date of the drawing to claim their prizes by mail, or at the Lottery's Madison or Milwaukee offices.

Wisconsin Lottery retailers who sell winning tickets with prizes of \$600 or more earn the equivalent of 2% of the prize, up to a maximum commission of \$100,000. Waterford Self Serve earns \$4,000 on Donaghy's ticket. M & R Travelmart in Baraboo earns \$600 on Foss's Power Play ticket. The \$10,000 winning ticket retailers each earn \$200.

Wednesday's winning Powerball numbers **05, 06, 12, 16 and 21, with a Powerball of 07.** The Power Play prize multiplier was 03.
