Marshfield Powerball ticket worth \$1 million thanks to Power Play!



(Madison) —A ticket sold in Marshfield for the Saturday, May 30th Powerball drawing is worth \$1 million, thanks to the game's Power Play prize multiplier feature.

The ticket, sold at Baltus Car Wash, 539 S. Central Ave. in Marshfield, matched all five regular winning numbers in Saturday's drawing to earn the ticket holder a \$200,000 prize. But, because the player also purchased the Power Play prize multiplier feature, the \$200,000 prize was automatically multiplied by five.

Power Play turned the \$200,000 ticket into a \$1 million winner.

The ticket-holder has 180 days from Saturday's drawing to claim the prize. The \$1 million ticket must be validated at the Lottery's headquarters in Madison.

Saturday's winning Powerball numbers were 01, 23, 42, 51 and 59, with a Powerball of 20.

Power Play is a feature of Powerball that gives all non-jackpot winners a chance to multiply their prizes for an additional \$1 for each set of numbers they purchase. Before each Powerball drawing a Power Play number from 2-5 is drawn. With a Power Play purchase \$200,000 prizes are automatically multiplied by five. Prizes of \$3 to \$10,000 are multiplied by the Power Play number that is chosen in the drawing.

No one in any state matched all six winning numbers in the May 30th Powerball drawing. So the Powerball jackpot grows to \$25 million (est. annuity) for this Wednesday, June 3.
