Cedarburg man claims \$10,000 Powerball prize



(MADISON) —A \$1 Powerball quick pick ticket turned out to be worth \$10,000 to Robert Saler of Cedarburg.

With the only set of numbers on his ticket, Faulkner matched four of the five regular winning numbers and the Powerball in the Saturday, June 9 drawing to win his \$10,000 prize. He received a check for \$6,825 after taxes.

He purchased his winning ticket at Otto's Cedarburg Beverage Center, W63 N157 Washington in Cedarburg. For selling Saler's ticket, Otto's earns \$200. Lottery retailers who sell winning tickets with prizes of \$600 or more earn the equivalent of 2% of the prize, up to a maximum of \$100,000.
