## **\$30,000 Powerball “Power Play” winner in Dane County Megabucks jackpot at \$12.6 million!**



(Madison) —No one in any state matched all five numbers plus the Powerball to win the jackpot in the Wednesday, June 13 Powerball drawing, pushing the new jackpot for Saturday, June 16 to \$66 million (estimated annuity).

One ticket sold in Wisconsin for last night’s drawing matched four of the five regular winning numbers plus the Powerball to win a prize of \$10,000. But, because the player also purchased the game’s “Power Play” multiplier feature, that \$10,000 win turned out to be worth \$30,000.

**The \$30,000 winning ticket was purchased at Pick ‘N Save, 6655 McKee Road in Madison.**

Last night’s winning Powerball numbers were **10, 13, 28, 30 and 47**. The Powerball was **26** and the Power Play prize multiplier number, which turned the Madison ticket into a \$30,000 winner, was **03**.

Power Play is a feature of Powerball that gives players a chance to multiply their non-jackpot prizes by 2, 3, 4, or 5 times. Players must choose the Power Play option at the time they purchase their tickets. Power Play costs \$1 for each set of Powerball numbers played.



No one matched all six winning numbers to claim the jackpot in the Wednesday, June 13 Megabucks drawing. Last night’s winning Megabucks numbers were **02, 10, 14, 28, 36 and 42**. The new jackpot for Saturday, June 16 moves to \$12.6 million (estimated annuity).
