Powerball winners claim \$70,000 in June prizes *Six big prizes in five counties*



(Madison) —A half a dozen Wisconsin Lottery Powerball players have turned their winning tickets from the first part of June into some cold hard cash.

West Bend's Darren Hess leads the way with a June 10th **\$20,000** Power Play ticket he purchased at Deli Food Xpress, 1700 E. Washington Ave. Hess matched four of the five regular winning numbers PLUS the Powerball in the June 10th drawing to win \$10,000. But, because he also purchased the Power Play prize multiplier feature his prize became \$20,000 after it was multiplied by the night's Power Play number, which was two.

Other winners from the July 10th drawing include:

Appleton's Robert Roett who won **\$10,000** on a ticket he bought from Richmond Citgo, 1601 N. Richmond St.

Burlington's Steve Narlock who won **\$10,000** with a ticket purchased at JMP Burlington Petroleum, 500 E. State St.

Lester Best of Colgate, whose **\$10,000** winner came on a ticket he bought at Silver Spring Corner Pump, N56 W17450 Silverspring Rd. in Menomonee Falls.

Two \$10,000 Powerball winners in the June 6th drawing have also claimed their prizes.

Marc Collignon of Shorewood won with a ticket bought at Wick's Beer & Liquor, 4496 N. Oakland Ave. in Shorewood. **Kevin Brown of Racine** bought his \$10,000 winner at Village Food * Liquor Mart, 8929 Durand Ave. in Sturtevant.

The Deli Food Xpress in West Bend earns a \$400 commission from the Lottery for selling the \$20,000 Power Play ticket. The stores that sold the \$10,000 winners each earn \$200. Lottery retailers who sell tickets with prizes of \$600 or more earn the equivalent of 2% of the prize, up to a maximum of \$100,000.
