## Oshkosh, Waunakee Powerball winners claim prizes



(Madison) —That didn't take long.

Two of the three people who won \$10,000 in the Wisconsin Lottery's Saturday, June 20 Powerball drawing have already claimed their prizes.

**William Hafemann of Oshkosh** validated the \$10,000 winning ticket that he bought at Lang Oil, 403 N. Sawyer, in Oshkosh.

**Richard Lange of Waunakee** turned in the \$10,000 winner he purchased at Kwik Trip, 208 E. Main St., Waunakee.

Hafemann and Lange bought \$5 quick pick tickets for Saturday's drawing. One set of numbers on their tickets matched four of the five regular winning numbers Saturday plus the Powerball to land them their \$10,000 prizes.

Saturday's winning Powerball numbers were 03, 11, 18, 22 and 28 with a Powerball of 33. The Power Play prize multiplier was 02.

For selling Hafemann's and Lange's \$10,000 tickets, Lang Oil and Kwik Trip earn \$200 from the Lottery. Lottery retailers who sell winning tickets with prizes of \$600 or less earn a commission equivalent to 2% of the prize, up to a maximum of \$100,000.

A third \$10,000 winner from Saturday's Powerball drawing has not yet been claimed. That ticket was sold in Muskego.
