Oshkosh man claims \$200,000 Powerball prize with ticket purchased in Green Bay



(Madison)— **Jimmy Coliades of Oshkosh** may have found a new home away from home in Green Bay.

Coliades stopped at Jackson Pointe Inc. Citgo at 2710 S. Packerland in Green Bay and purchased a \$5 quick-pick ticket for the June 23rd Powerball drawing. One set of numbers on that ticket wound up matching all five regular winning Powerball numbers drawn on the 23rd.

It also wound up bringing Coliades a Wisconsin Lottery prize of \$200,000.

The five winning numbers Coliades matched were 14, 15, 27, 43 and 53. The Powerball was 28 and the Power Play was 4.

Coliades receives \$136,500 after taxes. For selling his winning ticket the Pine Ridge Convenience Store earns \$4,000. Wisconsin Lottery retailers who sell winning tickets with prizes of \$600 or more earn the equivalent of 2% of the prize, up to a maximum of \$100,000.
