\$10,000 Powerball prize claimed in Pleasant Prairie



(MADISON) —A \$3 Powerball quick pick ticket turned out to be worth \$10,000 to Doris Hogue of Pleasant Prairie.

With the one of the three sets of numbers on the ticket, Hogue matched four of the five regular winning numbers and the Powerball in the Saturday, July 7th drawing to win a \$10,000 prize. Hogue received a check for \$6,825 after taxes.

The winning ticket was purchased at Pick N' Save, 5710 75th St. in Kenosha. For selling Hogue's ticket, Pick N' Save earns \$200. Lottery retailers who sell winning tickets with prizes of \$600 or more earn the equivalent of 2% of the prize, up to a maximum of \$100,000.
