Osseo man claims \$10,000 Powerball prize *Bought his winner in Strum*



(Madison) —Chad Riphenburg of Osseo knew he had a special ticket. He just didn't know how special.

Following the Wisconsin Lottery's July 22 Powerball drawing Riphenburg took his \$1 quick pick ticket to a store near his home and scanned it using one of the Lottery's automated ticket checkers.

"It said 'Claim at Lottery,'" Riphenburg said. "I'd never seen that before."

After consulting with the store clerk Riphenburg learned his ticket was worth \$10,000.

"That was a great surprise," he said.

Riphenburg brought his \$10,000 winning ticket to the Lottery's headquarters in Madison this afternoon. His ticket matched four of the five regular numbers drawn on the 22nd, plus the Powerball. Those winning numbers were 04, 06, 16, 22 and 32, with a Powerball of 11.

Riphenburg receives \$6,725 after taxes.

For selling Riphenburg's winning ticket the Strum Cenex Convenience Store in Strum earns a \$200 commission. Lottery retailers who sell winning tickets with prizes of \$600 or more earn the equivalent of 2% of the prize, up to a maximum of \$100,000.
