## **\$314.3 million Powerball jackpot won in Indiana; Megabucks jackpot rolls to \$1.6 million;** *Six \$10,000 Powerball winners in Wisconsin*



(Madison) —A ticket in Indiana matched all five numbers plus the Powerball to win the \$314.3 million jackpot in the Saturday, August 25 drawing, and six tickets sold in Wisconsin for Saturday night's drawing matched four of the five regular winning numbers plus the Powerball to win a prize of \$10,000. The new Powerball jackpot for Wednesday, August 29 will be \$15 million (estimated annuity).

**The \$10,000 winning tickets were purchased at Speedway, 3708 60<sup>th</sup> St. in Kenosha; Godin Grocers, 6111 W. Mequon Rd. in Mequon; Countryside Convenience Center, 20015 93<sup>rd</sup> St. in Bristol; Mr. T's Easy Stop, Rt. 1 101 Cty. Hwy. Rd. YZ in Dodgeville; Butte Des Morts Mobil, 5761 Hwy. 110 in Butte Des Morts; and Wagner Shell, 709 S. Superior St. in Antigo.**

Saturday night's winning Powerball numbers were **02, 08, 23, 29 and 35**. The Powerball was **19** and the Power Play prize multiplier number was **03**.



No one matched all six Megabucks numbers to win the jackpot in the Saturday, August 25 drawing. Saturday night's winning Megabucks numbers were **02, 13, 15, 16, 29 and 47**. The new jackpot for Wednesday, August 29 is \$1.6 million (estimated annuity).
